SINGAPORE BORDER CONTROL MEASURES

For Singapore Residents and Long-term Pass Holders

All new travellers arriving from high-risk countries and regions will have their stay-home notice (SHN) cut to 14 days, instead of 21 days, as of 27 June 2021. However, they must take an antigen rapid test [using self-test kits](#) on the third, seventh and 11th day after arriving in Singapore.

All short-term visitors will not be allowed to enter or transit through Singapore except in extenuating situations. Short-term visitors who are granted entry into Singapore will be issued with a 14-day SHN.

- All Singaporeans and residents of Singapore are advised to defer all travel abroad. However, essential business and official travel will be permitted under Green/ Fast Lane arrangements

To tackle the COVID-19 situation, many countries have imposed entry restrictions and border closures. Please refer to the [International Air Transport Association \(IATA\) Travel Centre website](#) when planning your travel routes. As the measures imposed could result in flight cancellations and reduction in flight frequency, you are advised to check with your airline or travel agency to ensure that your flight routes are still operating prior to departing for the airport.

- Check with the immigration authority or embassy of the destination country/region on the relevant health requirements imposed on travellers from Singapore, such as Pre-Departure Tests to be taken



1.97M (6.2%) of population fully vaccinated as at 25 June.

- Malaysia will extend its full lockdown until daily new Covid-19 cases drop below 4,000, and its targets on vaccination and intensive care unit (ICU) bed usage are met. Malaysia is still averaging above 5,000 cases a day nearly four weeks into the lockdown.
- The country needs to achieve full vaccination for 10 per cent of its population in order to move into phase two, but only 6.2 per cent had been fully inoculated as at Saturday (June 26).



- Indonesia is currently not allowing any non-Indonesian nationals to enter the country until further notice. Exemptions to this include diplomats on official business, holders of Indonesian residency cards, foreigners who are travelling for official business, humanitarian aid, essential work or other essential reasons.
- As the government struggles to speed up its vaccination drive and ensure public adherence to hygiene and social distancing measures, the rapid spread of the virus threatens to overwhelm Indonesia's health system.

Philippines Covid situation update as of 27 June 2021

2.25M (2.1%) people have been fully vaccinated as at 22 June.

- The Philippine president has eased a coronavirus lockdown in the capital and adjacent provinces to fight economic recession and hunger but still barred public gatherings this month.
- The Philippine President also extended a ban on inbound travel from India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal, Oman, and the United Arab Emirates until Jun 15, to prevent transmission of the coronavirus variant that is circulating widely in India and the region.



- COVID-19 remains a serious health risk. Infection numbers remain high and the health system is under pressure. A State of Emergency is in place. Lockdown arrangements are in place for Dili and isolation zones apply in several municipalities.
- No flights to Timor from Singapore are available.
- Entry restrictions apply to all travellers (air, land and sea) and can change with little notice.



2.55M (3.7%) of population have been fully vaccinated as at 25 Jun.

- Travelers from [56 countries](#) can now enter Thailand under the Visa Exemption Scheme. However, these travelers still need to comply with Thailand's 14-day mandatory quarantine and show proof of a negative PCR test.
- Thailand ordered restaurants in its capital city Bangkok and nearby provinces to suspend dine-in services for a month.
- Shopping malls in Bangkok and its neighbouring provinces will be closed by 9pm. All gatherings of more than 20 people, seminars and conferences are banned in Bangkok and the five provinces



- Vietnam has suspended the entry of all foreigners since March 22, 2020, until further notice to limit the spread of COVID-19. The measure will not apply to diplomats, officials, foreign investors, experts, and skilled workers.
- Vietnam's Ministry of Health extended the mandatory quarantine period to 21 days from the previous 14-day requirement from May 5.
- Both Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City have suspended international arriving flights to deal with the local outbreak, though outbound international departures can continue as normal. Ho Chi Minh has also limited domestic flights.



- Nepal's Kathmandu valley entered a lockdown since 29 April and remains in lockdown at the present time.
- Most businesses, except for some banks and certain government offices, remain closed. Operational hours for grocery stores limited to hours between 0700 hours to 0900 hours, and pharmacies and health related shops are permitted to operate under normal hours.
- The Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal (CAAN) is allowing limited international flights from China, Qatar and Turkey from 1 June 2021.



- In view of the rapidly escalating clashes between protesters and the Myanmar security forces and increasing number of civilian casualties in Myanmar, Singaporeans are strongly advised to defer all travel to Myanmar at this time.
- Travelers should avoid all travel to Myanmar. Because of the current situation in Myanmar, even fully vaccinated travelers may be at risk for getting and spreading COVID-19 variants and should avoid all travel there.



- Health officials in Cambodia are maintaining international travel controls aimed at preventing the spread of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) activity, while easing domestic businesses restrictions.
- Cambodia ended a blanket coronavirus lockdown in Phnom Penh after three weeks, though authorities retained tighter curbs in some districts where infections have surged.
- Cambodian Embassies are only accepting applications for diplomatic, official, and sponsored business-linked visas, and are not issuing tourist or other visas to enter Cambodia.



- In view of the ongoing COVID-19 situation, international airline operations between India and Singapore remain suspended, except for international repatriation flights under India's Vande Bharat Mission.
- With effect from 22 April 2021, until further notice, all long-term visit pass holders and short-term visitors with recent travel history (including transit) to India within the last 14 days will not be allowed entry into Singapore, or transit through Singapore.
- Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents travelling from India are required to take a COVID-19 PCR test **upon arrival** in Singapore.
- Singapore has reduced the quarantine period for most inbound travellers from 21 days to two weeks.

- All foreign **tourists** are subject to a pre-arrival PCR test, with more testing required upon arrival. They must also stay at Covid-19 certified hotels. The pre-arrival PCR test requirement also applies to **tourists** who have received both doses of the vaccination.
- With the aim to bring down the infection rate, the government is planning to vaccinate at least 70 percent of its population by August or September this year.

- On 1 June, Mongolia reopened its air border to resume international passenger flights after more than a year of closure because of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, only people who have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine will be allowed to enter the country.



- At present, all foreign nationalities are barred from visiting Japan as tourists.
- Due to the spread of new, more contagious strains of the virus, Japan is closing its borders until further notice to all new foreign arrivals except foreign residents of Japan or under special circumstances.
- It is currently undecided when regular tourists will again be able to enter the country, but it is unlikely to happen before autumn 2021.
- It has been confirmed that international spectators will not be allowed to attend the Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics.


223M of the population have been fully vaccinated as at 26 June.

- From 6 November 2020, Singapore has lifted our border restrictions for visitors from Mainland China.
- Singaporeans and residents of Singapore may travel to Mainland China, although travellers are still advised to check the entry requirements imposed by China and take the necessary precautionary measures.
- All persons must have negative results from both a nucleic acid test and a serological test for COVID-19 issued no more than 48 hours prior to departure.
- All persons must undergo testing and a 14 day quarantine. Arrivals to Shanghai may undergo a 7-day quarantine + 7 days self-isolation at home.



- Considering the recent escalation of COVID-19 cases internationally and within Taiwan, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that entry to Taiwan will be suspended from May 19 for foreign nationals.
- Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis for emergencies and on humanitarian grounds.



- Except for flights from UK, other travellers may still continue their journey on non-designated air travel bubble flights, but such travellers will be subject to the prevailing border control and health requirements of both places.
- Hong Kong will shorten hotel quarantine to seven days for fully vaccinated residents travelling from most places, as well as non-residents inoculated against Covid-19.

Summary as of 27 June 2021

Based on the current spread of Covid 19 in the various regions, we have made the following observations:

1. In SEA, the spread in Singapore seems to be flattening. Infections in Malaysia have increased significantly, while in the Philippines cases are on the downward trend. In Indonesia cases have spiked to the highest the country has seen since the beginning of the Covid 19 outbreak. The daily average has been about 18,000 cases this past week. In Timor Leste the case numbers are reducing, averaging below 50 cases for the past week.
2. In Indochina, the spread is on a downward trend in Nepal with average daily cases below 2000 this past week. However, case numbers have been increasing in Thailand, Vietnam, Cambodia and Myanmar.
3. In South Asia, the spread is on the downward trend in both India and Sri Lanka. In Sri Lanka the weekly average number of cases is below 2,000 while in India, the weekly average is around 50,000 cases.
4. In East Asia, the spread in Mongolia continues to spike. In Japan and Taiwan, cases have dipped. Cases remain low in China and Hong Kong.
4. With covid vaccinations having started in many Asian countries, it is hoped that numbers will begin to be controlled. However, with new mutations, many countries are seeing an increase in cases again, resulting in stricter measures within countries and travel across countries.
